

Very low participation of students with special needs in Erasmus

only 0.17% in 2008-2009

MAIN CHALLENGES IDENTIFIED

- Physical barriers at universities
- · Accessible learning materials
- Limited personal assistance
- Teachers' mindset
- Freedom of choice
- Lack of financial resources
- Accessibility of cities and transports
- Lack of information about mobility programmes
- Incompatibility of services in terms of mobility
- · Employability after studies
